| Abstract | The Corps of Engineers evaluated ecosystem restoration project through cost effectiveness and incremental cost analysis (CD/ICA). This means that Corps seeks out to choose site specific alternative based on the lowest costs and greatest environmental output. Once the best base plan is found, incremental analysis finds the next best additional increments or restoration. This process can be done using a computer model called IWR Planning Suite. This presentation will discuss the CD/ICA process and the model used to conduct this analysis. |
